

CAREER EVENTS COMMITTEE

The Career Events Committee is a dedicated team that organizes events to connect students with companies and to bridge the gap between studying and the start of your career. These events range from monthly workshops and in-house days to our association's flagship career event 'CSA Career Days'.

ACTIVITIES AS AN ACTIVE MEMBER OF THE CAREER EVENTS COMMITTEE

As an active member in the Career Events Committee you will organise the association's flagship career event 'CSA Career Days'. This flagship event revolves around connecting ambitious students and young professionals to globally oriented companies. Additionally, members of The Career Events committee will also organize company dinners, in-house days and career-related workshops. The purpose of this committee is to fill the gap that arises once students decide to start their career. You will contribute to bridging business cultures and assist in establishing career paths for students where they can grow professionally. The Career Events Committee will have several roles to keep the responsibilities clear and manageable. There will be various roles and functions such as:

HEAD OF THE CAREER EVENTS COMMITTEE

Together with the Commissioner of External Affairs, you will come up with strategies to improve the career events. Besides that you will be in charge of leading the Career Events Committee, oversee all activities within the committee and monitor the developments of the Career Events members. As the head of the committee you need to be able to maintain a family-like feeling within the team. You will also have the opportunity to approach companies, arrange appointments, acquire partnerships and organize small and large events throughout the year. If you're driven to continue strengthening and expanding the corporate partner portfolio of CSA, be sure to apply to the Head position!

TREASURER

As Treasurer of the Career Events Committee, you will keep financial oversight of the Committee. This role consists of making budget plans and keeping track of all declaration forms that need to be approved by the Treasurer of the Board. It would be preferred to have an affinity with basic accounting knowledge.

COMMISSIONER OF MARKETING

The Commissioner of Marketing is responsible for the marketing content of CSA Career Days. Together with the head you will set up and execute the promotion plan for CSA Career Days and all other career-related events. In short, you will be the creative engine behind our public presence. Therefore, some knowledge and experience in designing promotional material would be advantageous.

COMMISSIONER OF EVENTS

The Commissioner of Events helps keep an overview in planning both our flagship events and our monthly events. They are, among other things, in charge of making the rundown schedule, list of goods to be purchased but also the coordination of the event venue. As Commissioner of Events, it is important that you're able to work in an organised and orderly manner.

COMMISSIONER OF COMMUNICATION & IT

The Commissioner of Communication & IT is responsible for taking care of the overall Career Days database and communication regarding organising CSA Career Days. They will also assist the head with communication between the association and academic institutions. It would be beneficial to have a good command of Dutch in both writing and speech. In addition, it is also important that you are organised and structured.

COMMISSIONER OF COMMERCIAL RELATIONS

As The Commissioner of Commercial Relations, you are mainly responsible for coordinating the general sales strategy with the head. You will also need to keep an overview of the Committee's business partners and ensure that the whole team achieves the sponsor target. Sales experience and a love to work with external parties is a plus.

COMMISSIONER OF INTERNAL AFFAIRS

The Commissioner of Internal Affairs manages the collaborations with other student and cultural associations, ensuring smooth communication and coordination for joint events, especially during Career Days. Strong communication skills and a proactive attitude are essential.
