Beyond course management, the committee organizes Language Cafés and a variety of educational events, such as calligraphy workshops, trivia nights, and soju cantus, that foster community engagement and enrich the language learning journey. ACTIVITIES AS AN ACTIVE MEMBER OF THE EDUCATION COMMITTEE

A crucial responsibility is to promote CSA's language courses, and as a result, you will develop your sales skills throughout the year. The expected workload of the Education Committee is **5 to 6 hours** per week.

HEAD POSITION

The Head of the Education Committee is responsible for leading the committee and is the intermediary between the Committee and the Board. Apart from the profile that is described above, we are looking for a Head of the Education Committee who:

- Possesses strong critical thinking skills and is able to think big picture about the committee's processes and language courses
- Is passionate about bringing people together and motivating others
- Is not afraid to give feedback and help out committee members when needed

COURSE MANAGER (DUTCH, MANDARIN OR CANTONESE)

The Course Managers for the Dutch, Mandarin and Cantonese courses are responsible for ensuring that the language courses go smoothly. As the main point of contact for the teachers, you will maintain regular communication with them, support them in preparing class and exam materials, and assist in managing the course's online environment. You will also lead teacher meetings, collect feedback from teachers, and find ways to improve the language course's quality. For effective communication and support, it is crucial to be fluent in the language that you will be the Course Manager for.

SECRETARY

The Secretary is responsible for managing messages from course takers via email or text, and discusses them with the rest of the committee. These could be about the language course, educational events, or other initiatives the committee is involved in. You will also be responsible for ensuring that the scheduling and delivery of teacher materials for language classes for every trimester goes smoothly.

EVENTS MANAGER

The Events Manager is responsible for the planning and execution of the Education's Committee events, ranging from educational events, to Language Buddy Events and Language Cafés, while also serving as the main point of contact in your committee when collaborating with other committees. These events will provide opportunities for people interested in learning new languages and cultures to connect, learn, and socialize through activities such as trivia nights, calligraphy workshops, soju cantus, karaoke nights, and more.

SOCIAL MEDIA MANAGER

The Social Media Manager is responsible for assisting the Marketing Committee in managing CSA's Chinese social media platforms (WeChat and XiaoHongShu). In this role, you will help schedule, publish, and monitor content on these platforms to ensure consistent and engaging communication. A key part of your responsibility is to assist in creating content that highlights and promotes the Education Committee's language courses, events, and other initiatives across all social media channels. In addition, you will help keep the platforms safe and professional by monitoring for inappropriate advertisements or posts from members.

Keep in mind that having a specialized role does not mean that your activities will be monotonous and limited to your function. All committee members will be working closely together with each other's responsibilities, and there will be plenty of room to come up with new ideas on how to improve and promote the language courses and engage members together.
