

INTERNAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE

For the upcoming academic year of 2026/2027, CSA Rotterdam is recruiting active members for the Internal Relations Committee. Your main responsibility will be organizing engaging activities for our internal community, which are fellow active members and CSA Alumni, with the goal to foster a lasting family-like feeling. As an Internal Relations Committee member, you are able to hit it off with strangers at the first exchange of words and encourage meaningful connections within our diverse internal community.

ACTIVITIES AS AN ACTIVE MEMBER OF THE INTERNAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE

The Internal Relations Committee prioritizes building a close-knit internal community by hosting events that inspire connection. Your day-to-day tasks include brainstorming about event concepts, arranging a suitable venue and activity, creating budget and marketing plans, as well as evaluating feedback from attendees. Together as a committee, you are expected to hold weekly meetings to go over the rundown of your events and address or resolve possible needs or issues, with an expected workload of **6 to 8 hours** per week.

In addition, within our internal community, we have two target audiences: the active members and the [CSA Alumni Network](#). For each, there are separate event categories, namely internal events and alumni events. These are explained in more detail below.

ABOUT INTERNAL EVENTS

Throughout the year, internal events are frequently hosted to accommodate bonding opportunities between all of our active members. As an Internal Relations Committee member, you play a key role in creating events that are inclusive and accessible. Such events can range from a spontaneous board games night on some Wednesday evening to a fully arranged get-together with a specific program, such as playing an escape room followed by eating dinner. Returning events include Actives Weekend and Secret Santa.

ABOUT ALUMNI EVENTS

Reconnecting with former active members is highly valued within CSA. Therefore, the Internal Relations Committee is in charge of providing opportunities for CSA Alumni to interact with each other, as well as with the association at present. Casual drinks and Alumni Buddy System are notable examples. The main goal for alumni events is to provide a low-barrier channel for alumni members to reengage with CSA and relive the nostalgia with their peers through social (re)connection.

WHAT WE LOOK FOR

The overarching goal is to create and sustain a family-like feeling among the internal community, which you will be in charge of with your fellow committee members! Therefore, we are looking for people who fit the following description. As a member of the Internal Relations Committee, you are:

- **Sociable:** you excel at adapting to new environments and are able to smoothly foster positive interactions with others, embracing inclusivity and diversity.

- Communicate frequently and transparently to your fellow committee members and the supervisor about the committee's state of affairs throughout the year.
