ACTIVITIES AS AN ACTIVE MEMBER OF THE STUDY TRIP COMMITTEE

It is the Study Trip Committee's responsibility to organize one of the flagship events of CSA; the annual Study Trip, which will take place around springtime 2027. The Study Trip is a very popular event, due to its interplay between cultural, social and academic exchange. The main goal of the trip is to get students acquainted with Chinese culture and business ethics while showcasing the beauty and rich cultures China has to offer.

From choosing the cities that Study Trip 26/27 will travel to, to contacting companies, businesses and universities in China, and budgeting flight tickets, hotels and activities, the Study Trip Committee is responsible for shaping the entire journey from concept to execution. The committee ensures that the programme is well-balanced, financially feasible, and meaningful for all participants, combining professional insights, cultural exploration, and social bonding throughout the trip. The expected workload of the Study Trip Committee is **7 to 9 hours** per week.

Within the committee, you will be working with a motivated and diverse group of people. Every member will have various roles and functions such as:

HEAD POSITION

The Head of the Study Trip Committee will act as the intermediary between the Board and the committee. The responsibilities of the Head include scheduling and leading committee meetings, the overall planning processes, and keeping an overview of all the tasks of the individual committee members.

TREASURER

The Treasurer is responsible for the general financial oversight, budgeting, bookkeeping and financial reporting. The Study Trip Treasurer works closely together with the Treasurer of the CSA Board.

EXTERNAL RELATIONS COORDINATOR

The External Relations Coordinator is responsible for the acquisition of companies that will sponsor the trip. The External Relations Coordinator will foresee company and university visits during the Study Trip. (Mandarin Chinese Language skills are a plus!)

MARKETING & COMMUNICATIONS COORDINATOR

The Marketing & Communications Coordinator is responsible for the promotion of the Study Trip and communicating with the participants. This includes making the marketing post and making an overview of all important information for the trip, but also looking out for the group and mingling well with the participants.

PROGRAMME COORDINATOR

The Program Coordinator is the contact person during the trip and arranges all practical matters that are necessary to create an unforgettable program, including accommodations, transport, dinners, and all the activities. Mandarin Chinese language skills are a plus!

Keep in mind that having a specialized role does not mean that your activities will be monotonous and limited to your function. During the year, you will be working closely together with all the committee members and you will have room to bring in all your input and ideas!
